Subject: Adjustment of the vessel attendance conditions in Dakar Port.

We hereby inform the ship-owners, shipping agents and port operators, due to the spread of the COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) outbreak, the vessels' boarding conditions attendance of the port of Dakar have been modified to adapt to the new situation.

Therefore, all vessels scheduled to call Dakar Port will now have send by email to the port authority ([capitainerie@portdakar.sn](mailto:capitainerie@portdakar.sn)) and the Health department (Sea border health control) ([Csfmsn@gmail.com](mailto:Csfmsn@gmail.com)), latest 72 hours prior to her arrival the following documents:

- The list of the 10 previous port of call
- The maritime health declaration
- The crew list clearly stressing **the date and port where each crew member boarded the vessel**

Any vessel coming from countries (areas) impacted by the COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) will be attended at anchorage by the Health department in charge Sea border sanitary control (**Service de Contrôle Sanitaire aux Frontières Maritimes**) who will grant the free pratique and the authority to proceed before the vessel is allowed to enter to Dakar port.
