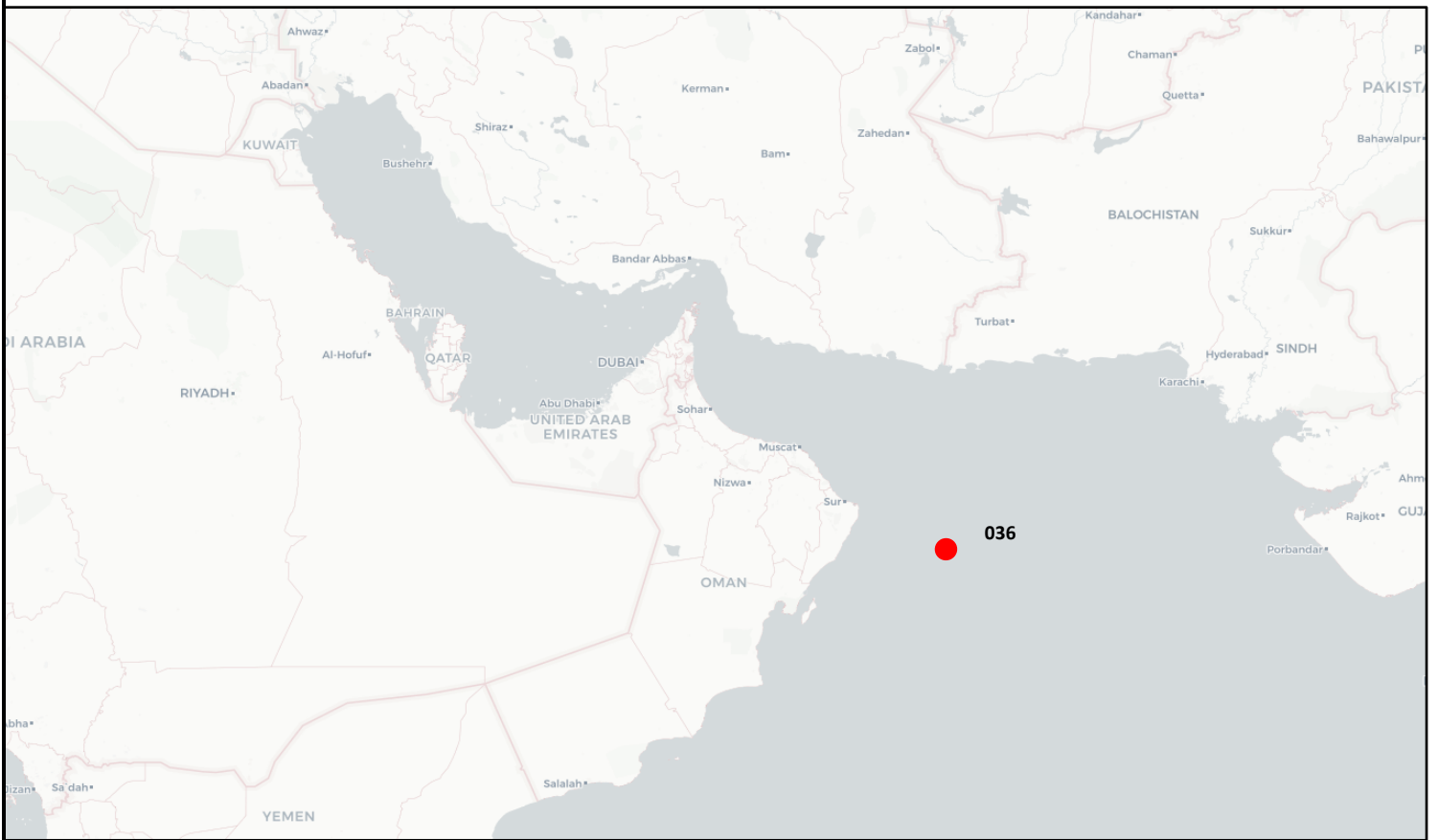


UKMTO DAILY SUMMARY

Daily Overview: No confirmed incidents reported to UKMTO during this reporting period. However, UKMTO did issue a (very) time late warning, verifying an incident on the 7 Apr. The regional security environment remains volatile, with ongoing military activity and continued threats to commercial shipping.

036-26 GOLD AUTUMN	07 APR 26 (TIMELATE)	<p>UKMTO has received a verified report of an incident on 07 Apr 26, 112NM southeast of Ras Al Hadd, Oman. The Master of a Bulk Carrier reported to authorities that his vessel was struck by two unidentified projectiles resulting in a fire onboard. A Pakistan Naval vessel rendered assistance and the incident is now reported complete.</p> <p>This UKMTO warning reports the same incident that JMICC Pakistan Alert 94/26 issued last week.</p>
